

Angels and Fairies Dolls Supply List

Note: This class will expose students to fumes from burning materials, please be aware if you are sensitive to scents or fumes.

Student Supplies bring to class:

- Sharp fabric scissors 8" and/or 5"
- Scissors to cut paper and wire ribbon
- Rotary cutter, ruler, and mat
- Fine point black sharpie marker and a lead pencil
- Sewing machine with zigzag stitch
- Monofilament Thread – clear not black, recommended brands Madeira or Superior Threads
- Bobbin wound with monofilament thread (please do this before class)
- Embroidery thread and bobbin for outlining the body of the doll – color to match doll body fabric
- 1 box of mini brads - These brads are approximately 1/8" across. Can be found at Michaels or on line at <http://www.createforless.com> - search for mini brads
- Fabric for doll:
 - 1/4 yard of organza to make wings and skirts
 - 1/4 yard of double sided fusible such as Fast2Fuse from C&T Publishing or Pellon Peltex II (72F) (check with store to see what they have in stock)
 - 1/8 yard of fabric for the doll body
 - Transparent ribbon for hair – recommended size 1/8 to 3/8 inch width in color to match or contrast fabric
- Teflon pressing sheet
- \$20 Kit Fee: Includes hand out, templates, doll arms/legs, Angelina Fiber, silk pods and fabric paints used in class

Optional

- Transparent ribbon and glitzy trim – bring enough to share with others class – we will pool resources for greater variety and choices
- Small feathers if you want them on the wings
- Fusible decorative thread such as Krenick and Clover mini iron to attach the thread
- Heat tool for burning – like ones used to burn stencils or wood
- 1 inch foam brushes
