

Thread Play Supply List

Student Supplies bring to class:

- One pillow 12x12 inch in size for the inside of pillow
- 1 fat quarter of fabric for pillow back and sides
- 1 fat quarter of contrasting fabric for accent border strips
- * ½ yard of light colored fabric for thread play learning and finished square – cut this fabric into 10 inch squares before class for approx. 4 10x10 inch squares (see optional note below)
- ½ yard of white craft felt or batting – cut this into 10 inch squares before class
- A design or doodle of your choice that you will translate into thread play – instructor will supply some examples if you don't bring one
- 4 – 6 sheets of tear away translucent Foundation paper – you will be sewing through this paper on to your fabric, and you may want to trace your design that is why it needs to be translucent
- Hot fix flat backed Swarovski crystals
- Heat tool to set crystals
- Sharp fabric scissors 8" and/or 5"
- Scissors to cut paper
- Rotary cutter, ruler, and mat
- Fine point black sharpie marker and a lead pencil
- Iron and ironing surface – check with the store they may supply
- Sewing machine with straight stitch
- Polyester or Rayon thread in 5-6 coordinating colors – get brand used for machine embroidery
- Extra filled bobbins (wind before class or buy pre-wound). See what store recommends for your machine and for your top thread.

Optional

- * Note: Pre-cut 10" squares - can be used instead of light colored fabric, these sets are called Layer Cake or Crackers, etc. Be sure there are at least four light colored blocks in the set
- Extra sewing machine needles. See what store recommends for 40 weight thread: Inspira Quilting Needle, Superior Topstitch #90/14, Schmetz Quilting 90, etc.

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
